REVISION OF CHARGES AT OFF-STREET CAR PARKS

The District of Woodspring (Off-Street Parking Places) (Weston-super-Mare) (No. 1) Order, 1977

Notice is hereby given that the District Council propose to make an Order under Sections 31(1) and 84(D)(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and the 19th Schedule to the Local Government Act, 1972.

The effect of the Order will be:

- (a) To re-enact those provisions of the Borough of Weston-super-Mare (Off-Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order, 1970 which relate to the control and regulation of the Arcade Multi-Storey Car Park;
- (b) To increase charges at the Arcade Multi-Storey Car Park in accordance with the details set out below. The revised charges are being introduced to recover increased operating costs and to produce additional revenue in accordance with guidelines issued by Central Government;
