The Wimborne District Council (West Parley No. 1) Public Path Diversion Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on the 16th March 1977 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Wimborne District Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order if confirmed without modification will be to divert the public right of way running from Point A to Point B on the plan annexed to the Order to a line running from Point A to Point C on the plan annexed to the Order.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the Council Offices, Furzehill, Wimborne, and may be inspected free of charge on Mondays to Fridays between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.45 p.m.

Any representation or objection in respect of the Order may be sent in writing to the Chief Executive of Wimborne District Council, Council Offices, Furzehill, Wimborne, not later than 28 days from the first publication of this notice stating the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made or if any so made are withdrawn the Wimborne District Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment with the Order.

Wycombe District Council (Footpath No. 4—Spinfield Lane, Marlow) Public Path Diversion Order, 1976

Notice is hereby given that on 9th March 1977, the Wycombe District Council confirmed the above-named Order without modification.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the section of the public right of way, which commences from a point near Ryans Mount, Spinfield Lane, Marlow in the County of Buckingham and proceeds in a westerly direction to a point near No. 3 The Close, Spinfield Lane, aforesaid.

NOTICE OF GRANTING OF AUTHORISATION

OPENCAST COAL ACT 1958

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 1 of the Opencast Coal Act 1958, on 9th March 1977, granted to the National Coal Board the Glyn Glas South Authorisation 1977 to work coal by opencast operations or to cause or permit coal to be worked by such operations.
