

## DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Devon (Marine Parade and The Strand, Dawlish) (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that on the 7th March 1977 the Devon County Council made an Order under sections 28 (1) and 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended.

The effect of the Order which comes into effect on the 21st March 1977 is to provide disabled persons' parking places on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

*Lengths of road at Dawlish in the District of Teignbridge Marine Parade*, south-east side, between points 203 and 218 yards from its junction with Station Road (measured from the kerb line of Station Road).

*The Strand*, south side, between points 181 and 165 yards west of its junction with Piermont Place. (481)

## DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Devon (Various Streets, Dawlish) (Prohibition and Limitation of Waiting) (Comprehensive) Order 1977.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 7th March 1977 the Devon County Council made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended, varying, extending and consolidating traffic restrictions at Dawlish.

When the Order comes into effect on the 21st March 1977, you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle:

(a) at any time in specified lengths of the following roads:

(c) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in specified lengths of:

Leigham Court	The Strand

(d) for a longer period than one hour (no return within one hour) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in specified lengths of Hospital Hill and Park Road;

(e) for a longer period than one hour (no return within one hour) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from 1st May to 30th September in specified lengths of Albert Street, Alexandra Road, Brunswick Place and Old Town Street;

(f) for a longer period than fifteen minutes (no return within one hour) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from 1st May to 30th September in a specified length of Brunswick Place;

(g) for a longer period than two hours (no return within two hours) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from 1st May to 30th September in specified lengths of Marine Parade and Plantation Terrace;

(h) for a longer period than one hour (no return within one hour) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in specified lengths of The Strand.

Exemptions permit waiting for the purpose of boarding and alighting, loading or unloading, Post Office services, maintenance of the road, supply of gas, water and electricity, pursuance of statutory powers or duties, taking in petrol, oil or air from a garage. The statutory exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles are included.

Hackney carriages will be permitted to wait in those lengths of roads mentioned in (a) above on duly authorised and marked out cab ranks.

## WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*West Glamorgan County Council (Various Roads, Horton Village, Gower) (Prohibition of Entry Except for Access and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1977.*

Notice is hereby given that the West Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be:

- (a) To prohibit vehicles from entering the unadopted access road from its junction with Main Road, Horton Village to the Sea Beach Hotel.
- (b) To prohibit waiting at all times from 1st April to 30th September in any year on both sides of the Main North-South Access Road to Horton Village from Horton Cross to the Beaches Corner.
