CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

The Borough of Wrexham Maelor (Area No. 3) Smoke Control Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Wrexham Maelor Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 27th August 1976, made an Order entitled *The Borough of Wrexham Maelor (Area No. 3) Smoke Control Order 1976*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Wales, Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff, for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions specified in the Schedule to the Order and the limitations provided by virtue of Section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st September 1977, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State.

4. A copy of the Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Department of Administration and Legal Services, Guildhall, Wrexham, and at the office of the Chief Public Health Inspector, Rhosyllen House, Rhosyllen at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 25th March 1977.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

An area of 7.9 acres or thereabouts of land bounded on its north-eastern side by that length of Mold Road, Wrexham, between Numbers 47 and 51 Mold Road (inclusive), and the rear boundaries of Numbers 17 to 47 (odd numbers only) (inclusive) Mold Road; on its south-eastern side by the rear boundaries of Numbers 4 to 54 (even numbers only) Maesgwyn Road, Wrexham, and the north-eastern side of the access way adjoining Number 54 Maesgwyn Road, Wrexham; on its south-western side by the south-western boundary of the Maesgwyn Housing Estate; and on its north-western side by the north-western boundary of the said housing estate.

BERKSHIRE ROYAL COUNTY COUNCIL

Royal County of Berkshire (Ewendons Lane, Wokingham) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which is to prohibit waiting on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Order will come into operation on 28th March 1977.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 21st March apply to the High Court for this purpose.

BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL

The City of Birmingham District Council (Belwell Lane, etc., Sutton Coldfield) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1977.

Notice is hereby given that on the 11th March 1977, the City of Birmingham District Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the County Council of West Midlands, made the above named Order under section 1 (1), (2) (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of this Order is as follows:

To introduce no waiting between 8 a.m. and midnight in parts of the undermentioned lengths of road in the City of Birmingham;

Belwell Lane, Belwell Drive, Brentnall Drive, Drayton Close, Hill Village Road, Irnham Road and Mere Green Road.

This Order contains an exemption in respect of the loading and unloading of goods in the lengths of road set out above.

This Order revokes the Borough of Sutton Coldfield (Consolidation of Traffic Regulation and Waiting Restrictions, etc.) Order 1971, insofar as it relates to Belwell Lane, Hill Village Road and Mere Green Road in Schedules 6 and 7 of the Order.

This Order will come into operation on the 28th March 1977.

A copy of this Order and a map showing the restricted roads are available for inspection at the offices of the undersigned Highways (Agency) Division, 2nd Floor, Baskerville House, Birmingham, during normal working hours.

If any person wishes to question the validity of this Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to this Order, they may within six weeks from the 11th March 1977, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Buckinghamshire County Council (Prohibition of Driving) (Iver) Order 1977
