The effect of the Order is:

- (a) to make provision as to the use of the Fisher Street, Knaresborough, Car Park, in particular as to the class of vehicle which may be entitled to use it;
- (b) as to the conditions under which it may be used;
- (c) as to the removal therefrom of a vehicle left there in contravention of the Order and the safe custody of the vehicle;
- (d) as to the disposal of abandoned vehicles, and
- (e) to introduce a charge on Wednesdays of 20p per day or part thereof.

SOUTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The South Yorkshire County Council (Springfield Street, Barnsley) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order 1977

The South Yorkshire County Council (Residents' Parking Places, Barnsley) (No. 1) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that on 15th March 1977 the South Yorkshire County Council made two Orders under section 1(1), (2) and (3) and sections 28 and 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Orders which will come into operation on 28th March 1977 will be:

- (a) to prohibit waiting by vehicles on any of the sides of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
- (b) to authorise the use of each of the parts of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this notice as a parking place between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays being public holidays excepted) in such positions as are specified in relation to that road in the said Schedule 2 of such classes of vehicle also so specified as displays a valid permit issued upon application to the South Yorkshire County Council.

Exceptions to the prohibition at paragraph (a) above will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein, the supply of gas, water and electricity, in pursuance
