

Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974.

When this Order comes into operation no one will be permitted to drive a vehicle in a direction other than from west to east, in that length of Main Street, Ellenborough, Maryport, in the District of Allerdale, classified as U.2940 which extends from its junction with that length of Main Street classified as C.2007 to its junction with Dan Wilson Avenue.

Full details are contained in the draft Order, which, together with a map showing the restricted road and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of Allerdale District Council, Town Hall, Maryport and the office of the undersigned during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order, you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 20th May 1977.

(No. 1) Order, 1977*

Imposition of 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit

Notice is hereby given that on the 22nd April 1977 the Cumbria County Council made the above-named Order

under section 72 (3) and section 73 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972.

The Order, which comes into operation on the 6th May 1977, will impose a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the length of road concerned may be inspected at the offices of Eden District Council, Town Hall, Penrith, and at the office of the undersigned during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 22nd April 1977, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DACORUM DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Dacorum District Council (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Dacorum District Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 107 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertford in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1), (2), (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 have made the above Order the effect of which will be to prohibit or restrict waiting in the lengths of road shown in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order and revoke those parts of previous Traffic Orders shown in Schedule 3 to this Order.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for loading and unloading, boarding and alighting from vehicles, vehicles being used in the service of the Local Authority, a Water Authority, the Post Office or statutory undertakers in pursuance of statutory duties, Police, Fire and Ambulance or for disabled persons vehicles.

A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 2nd May 1977 and plans showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected at the Civic Centre, Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained in the Orders on the grounds that they are not within any powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 that any requirement of these Acts or of any instrument made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice, make application to the High Court for that purpose.

1. George Street, Berkhamsted ... On the north-east side from Nos. 41 to 59 inclusive.
2. Hillfield Road, Hemel Hempstead... On both sides from a point 44 yards east of the centre line of Alexandra Road eastwards to the eastern boundary of No. 27.
3. Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead ... On the east side from a point 79 yards north of the centre line of Hillfield Road to a point 40 yards northwards.
4. Church Road, Leverstock Green, Hemel Hempstead. On the south-east side for a distance of 12 yards from Bedmond Road and from a point 24 yards from Bedmond Road to Leverstock Green Road and on the north-west side for 7 yards both from Bedmond Road and Leverstock Green Road.
5. Barnacres Road, Hemel Hempstead On the west side from Candlefield Road to the north side of No. 44 Barnacres Road and on the east side from the southern boundary of No. 179 to the south-west boundary of No. 451.
6. Vicarage Lane, Kings Langley ... Both sides from the A41 to the east side of No. 13.
7. The Glebe, Kings Langley... ... Both sides.
