- (d) in pursuance of statutory powers and duties ; and
- (e) disabled person's parking, except when the ban of loading and unloading is in force.

WIRRAL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that Wirral Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Merseyside, propose to make the under-mentioned Orders under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974:

Metropolitan Borough of Wirral (Kendal Street and Cloughton Road, Birkenhead) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1977.

The effect of the above Order will be to prohibit any vehicle to enter or leave Kendal Street at its junction with Cloughton Road.

Metropolitan Borough of Wirral (Box Junctions (No. 1) Order 1977)

The effect of the above Order will be to prohibit the driving of a vehicle into a boxed area marked on the carriageway at the junctions specified in Schedule 1 to this notice, unless the way is clear for such vehicle to proceed immediately out of the boxed area.

There is an exception in the Order relating to vehicles used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

Metropolitan Borough of Wirral (Salisbury Street and Various Streets, Birkenhead) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1977.

The effect of the above Order will be to prohibit any vehicle to travel along the length of road specified in the first column of Schedule 2 to this notice other than in a direction specified in the second column of that Schedule.

Metropolitan Borough of Wirral (Service Road at the rear of the Premises on the Eastern Side of Milton Pavement and Cloughton Road, Birkenhead) (Prescribed Route) Order 1977.

The effect of the above Order will be that every person driving in a northerly direction in the service road at the rear of the premises on the eastern side of Milton Pavement shall cause that vehicle on reaching the junction of the aforesaid service road with Cloughton Road, to make a left-hand turn into Cloughton Road.

WREXHAM MAELOR BOROUGH COUNCIL

Wrexham Town Centre—Experimental Extension of Pedestrianised Areas

Notice is hereby given that the borough council, acting as agent of the Clwydd County Council, propose to make an Experimental Order, under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be as follows:

- (a) To prohibit driving from 10.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays in:

Hope Street—between its junction with Regent Street and a point opposite the boundary of 35-37 Hope Street.

Regent Street—between its junctions with Hill Street and Hope Street.

- (b) To prohibit driving at any time in:

Priory Street—from its junction with Regent Street for a distance of approximately 21.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.

Argyle Street—from its junction with Regent Street for a distance of approximately 61 metres in a north-easterly direction.

- (c) To suspend the existing one-way traffic Orders in respect of the remaining lengths of Priory Street and Argyle Street.

Exemptions in the Order will permit vehicles to be used in the lengths of roads referred to for certain specified purposes, e.g. in connection with building operations, etc.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with an illustrative map and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be examined at the Guildhall, Wrexham, during normal office hours.

Any objections to the proposed Order should be in writing, specifying the grounds on which they are made, and sent to the undersigned by the 11th July 1977.
