MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT 1971 SECTIONS 13 AND 14

Direction Prohibiting Exercise of Powers in Relation to Controlled Drugs

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with section 16 (2) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, that the Secretary of State has given the following direction, which took effect on 16th May 1977:

The Secretary of State, in pursuance of subsection (1) and also of subsection (2) of section 13 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, and in accordance with section 14 of that Act, by this Direction, prohibits Dr. Frederick Morton-Gore, M.R.C.S., L.R.C.P., M.B., Ch.B, whose registered address is 60 East India Dock Road, London E.14, a doctor within the meaning of that Act, from prescribing, administering and supplying and from authorising the administration and supply of any controlled drug within the meaning of that Act.

This Direction does not extend to the doing of anything in circumstances in which it might lawfully be done without being a doctor.

HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The London-Fishguard Trunk Road (Penfforddlas, near Carmarthen Improvement Side Roads) Order 1977

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Penfforddlas, near Carmarthen in the County of Dyfed, he has made under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 an Order, the effect of which is:

- (a) to authorise him:
 - (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter a highway,
 - (ii) to stop up a highway,
 - (iii) to construct a new highway
 all at Penfforddlas aforesaid, and
- (b) to provide for a transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Dyfed as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.
