New Link Road between *Grammar School Lane* and *Thirsk Road*, both sides, for its entire length.

North Yorkshire County Council (Harrogate) (East Parade/Park View) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County of North Yorkshire made an Order under section 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Local Government Act 1974.

The general nature and effect of the Order is to make provision as to the use of the Harrogate (East Parade/Park View) Parking Place and in particular as to the vehicles or class of vehicles which may be entitled to use it, as to the conditions on which they may use it and as to the removal therefrom of a vehicle left there in contravention of the Order and the safe custody of the vehicle.

Provision has been made in the Order to enable a charge for car parking to be made on any day other than a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or other public holiday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. The charge payable is at the rate of 10p for 2 hours and 20p for up to 12 hours with an excess charge of one pound.

Particulars of the classes of vehicle for which the said parking place is available are set out in the Order.
