PRICES AND CONSUMER PROTECTION

COUNTER-INFLATION ACT, 1973 (1973 c. 9)
Notice under Section 6 (2) and (3)

To: British Gas Corporation

The Price Commission, in exercise of their powers under section 6 (2) and (3) of the Counter-Inflation Act 1973, hereby give you notice requiring you to restrict prices or charges for the sale of goods or the performance of services in the course of business.

The said restriction requires that no increase shall be made in any price or charge (except an increase permitted under the Order of Consent signed by the Secretary of State for Energy on 28th March 1977) until such time as your profits (calculated in the manner set out in the Schedule to this notice) have, to the satisfaction of the Commission, been reduced by £36.6 million, such sum being the amount of the excess over your reference level which arose in the period of twelve months ending 31st March 1977.

SCHEDULE

For the purposes of this notice:

1. In calculating whether profits have been reduced, current profits are to be compared on an annual basis with the reference level.
2. In calculating current profits, there may be deducted any expenditure (provided that it is properly chargeable to revenue account) which is incurred during the period in question on engineering, maintenance, repair and services, notwithstanding that the said expenditure may have been originally programmed for the year 1976-77; but such deduction may only be made to the extent that the expenditure was not charged to revenue account in calculating profits for the period of twelve months ending 31st March 1977.
