The Cardiff-Llangurig Trunk Road (Doldowlod House-Holmes Corner Diversions Side Roads) (No. 2) Order 197.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

- 1. An Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959 providing that the superseded length of the Cardiff-Llangurig Trunk Road situated between a point on the Trunk Road about 80 metres north-west of the entrance to "Holmes" and a point on the Trunk Road about 180 metres south-west of its junction with Cilgu Road at Doldowlod in the County of Powys, shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation, and
- 2. An Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him to stop up the superseded length of the Cardiff-Llangurig Trunk Road, about 525 metres in length, described in paragraph 1 above at Doldowlod aforesaid.
