*Declaration of Nigg and Udale Bays Nature Reserve*

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 19 of the above-named Act as amended aforesaid (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") that by the Nigg and Udale Bays Nature Reserve No. 1 Declaration made on the 21st July 1977, it was declared by the Nature Conservancy Council that the following land has been established as a Nature Reserve by them under the provisions of the Act and is so to be managed, namely: land extending to 1,504 acres or thereby consisting of two areas of foreshore between high and low water mark of ordinary spring tides in the Ross and Cromarty District of Highland Region, as described in and shown coloured pink on the two maps attached to the said Declaration.

OPENCAST COAL ACT, 1958

Notice is hereby given that the National Coal Board intend to submit an application entitled the Eastwood Application, 1977 to the Secretary of State for an authorisation under section 1 of the Opencast Coal Act, 1958 to work coal by opencast operations or to cause or permit coal to be worked by such operations. The land which the National Coal Board require to occupy in this connection is described below. *Description of Land*

The land which is about 81 acres in extent is in the Metropolitan District of the Borough of Rotherham in the Metropolitan County of South Yorkshire. It is situated about 1.6 kilometres south of Rawmarsh, about 1.9 kilometres north-east of Rotherham and about 0.6 kilometres south-east of Parkgate. The land lies between the River Don to the south and the private road known as Aldwarke Lane to the north and north-east and is bounded on the north by that private road, on the north-east by Blackwater Dyke, on the south by the Sheffield and South Yorkshire Navigation Canal Rotherham Cut, on the south-east by the Aldwarke Sewage Works and on the west and north-west by the Woodburn Junction to Mexborough Branch railway.
