The City of Stoke-on-Trent (Centre of Hanley) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 20) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Stoke-on-Trent, acting as agents for the Staffordshire County Council, propose to make an Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order, which will incorporate in permanent form the provisions of the various experimental traffic regulation orders currently affecting the centre of Hanley, will be to:

- 2. Prohibit the driving of vehicles from any length of road specified in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto into the length of road specified in the second column of the said Second Schedule by way of the turning movement specified in the third column of the said Second Schedule.
- 3. Prohibit the driving of vehicles other than "buses" (which term shall include only "scheduled express carriages" and "stage carriages" as defined in Section 117 of the Road Traffic Act 1960 as amended) in any of the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule hereto, other than for the purpose of gaining access to premises situated in any road so specified (or in any road leading from any such road and specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto).
- 4. Prohibit the driving of vehicles in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto other than for the purpose of gaining access to premises situated in any road so specified (or in any road leading from any such road and specified in the Third Schedule hereto).
- 5. Prohibit the driving of vehicles other than "buses" (which term shall include only "scheduled express carriages" and "stage carriages" as defined in Section 117 of the Road Traffic Act 1960 as amended) in any of the lengths of road specified in Parts A and B of the Fifth Schedule hereto provided that pedal cycles may be ridden in the permitted direction in any of the lengths of road specified in Part B of the said Fifth Schedule.
- 6. Prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Sixth Schedule hereto,
- 7. Prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time other than disabled persons' vehicles displaying the requisite orange badge which may wait for periods in excess of the maximum period permitted under the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemption for Disabled Persons) (England & Wales) Regulations 1975 using the spaces marked on the carriageway in the length of road specified in the Seventh Schedule hereto.
- 8. Limit the waiting of vehicles up to 30 minutes (no return within 1 hour of leaving) from 8 am to 6 pm Monday to Saturday inclusive in the lengths of road specified in the Eighth Schedule hereto.
- 9. Prohibit the loading and unloading of vehicles from 8 am to 6 pm Monday to Saturday inclusive in any of the lengths of road specified in the Ninth Schedule hereto.
- 10. Prohibit the loading and unloading of vehicles from 7.30 am to 9.30 am and from 4.30 pm to 6 pm Monday to Friday inclusive and from 11.30 am to 1 pm on Saturdays in any of the lengths of road specified in the Tenth Schedule hereto.
