SALMON AND FRESHWATER FISHERIES ACT 1975

Byelaws—Fisheries

Notice is hereby given that the South West Water Authority intend to apply at the expiration of one calendar month from the date of publication of this Notice, for the confirmation by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food of Byelaws exempting from the provisions of any byelaws in force in their area:

1. (a) any officer of the Authority acting in his official capacity;
- (b) any person who, with the written permission of the Authority, uses any instrument or mode of fishing, or takes any fish, or fishes in any place or at any time prohibited by byelaw:
 - (i) for the purpose of artificial propagation of salmon, trout or freshwater fish;
 - (ii) for some scientific purpose;
 - (iii) for the purpose of the preservation or development of a private fishery;
 - (iv) for the purpose of removing any fish from waters in which they have been artificially propagated or reared; and
2. any person fishing with rod and line for trout who, with the written permission of the Authority, uses in waters other than rivers or streams, any lure or bait prohibited by byelaw.

During the period of one calendar month from the date of publication of this Notice, a printed copy of the said Byelaws will be deposited at the offices of the Authority at 3-5 Barnfield Road, Exeter, and will be open to public inspection, without charge, from Monday to Friday during the usual office hours. During the same period, printed copies of the Byelaws will be supplied on demand, free of charge to any person.

Any objection to the confirmation of the Byelaws should be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London, SW1P 2AE, so as to be received at that office before the expiration of the period of deposit of the Byelaws. NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made by the Anglian Water Authority by J. F.
