

WIRRAL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

Grange Precinct, Birkenhead (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd August 1977, Wirral Borough Council as agents for and with the consent of the County Council of Merseyside made the above Order under sections 31 and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of the Order is to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this Notice, which shows the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period of waiting and the scale of charges proposed for each parking place.

The Order comes into operation on 1st September 1977 and a copy thereof and map may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Department of Administration and Legal Services, Town Hall, Wallasey.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act of 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 22nd August 1977, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd August 1977, Wirral Borough Council as agent for and with the consent of the County Council of Merseyside made the above-mentioned Orders under section 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of the Order will be to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice. The car parks will be restricted to season ticket holders and the notice shows the class of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period of waiting and the scale of charges for each parking place.
