

- (b) from its junction with the C.3 road at Higham eastward for a distance of 760 metres ;
 (c) from its junction with the C.73 road at Saxham, eastward for a distance of 600 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Prohibition of vehicles proceeding in any direction other than westwards in the lengths of the Trunk Road A.45 specified below:

- (a) From its junction with the U.9 road westward for a distance of 380 metres ;
 (b) from its junction with the C.73 road South Street, Risby eastward for a distance of 220 metres.

The Trunk Road (Bicester Road, Aylesbury) (A.41) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (No. 2) Order 1977.

The Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 on the London-Aylesbury-Warwick-Birmingham Trunk Road (A.41).

The effect of the Order would be to prohibit waiting at any time on any day on those sides of Bicester Road, Aylesbury, specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
