Three routes to connect the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the Motorway with the roundabout constructed as part of the realigned London—Fishguard Trunk Road at Margam.

2. (Being two of the four routes described in the Schedule to the M4 Motorway (Stormy Down to Groes Section) and Connecting Roads (No. 2) Scheme 1975 (S.I. 1975 No. 1175).)

Two routes to the west of the roundabout at Pyle in the County of Mid Glamorgan (constructed in pursuance of the M4 Motorway (Stormy Down to Groes Section) and Connecting Roads Scheme (Side Roads) (No. 2) Order 1975 (S.I. 1975 No. 1175) to connect the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the part of the Motorway described above with the said roundabout.
