SOUTH GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of South Glamorgan (Doctor Parking Places) (Nos. 10, 11, 12 & 13) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on the 10th January 1978 the County Council of South Glamorgan in exercise of its powers under sections 35, 36 and 37 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by the Transport Act 1968 the Local Government Act 1972 and the Road Traffic Act 1974 made an Order the general effect of which is to prevent any person other than the Medical Practitioners who hold the permits issued by the Council in relation to the lengths of road referred to below from leaving any vehicle in those lengths of road between the hours stated:—

Parking Place No. 10

Partridge Road, Cardiff

On the north side from a point 8 metres north west of its junction with Newport Road, Cardiff, for a distance of 12 metres north west.—8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

Parking Place No. 11

Maitland Street, Cardiff

On the east side from a point 18 metres south of its junction with Whitchurch Road, Cardiff, for a distance of

6 metres south.—8.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday.

Parking Place No. 12

Cyril Crescent, Cardiff

On the south west side from a point 29 metres south east of its junction with Newport Road, Cardiff, for a distance of 6 metres in a south easterly direction.

Parking Place No. 13

Watson Street, Barry

On the west side from a point 15 metres north west of its junction with Holton Road, Barry, for a distance of 12 metres north west.

The Order which comes into effect on the 13th January 1978 will be known as "The County Council of South Glamorgan (Doctor Parking Places) (Nos. 10, 11, 12 and 13) Order 1978".

A copy of the Order and plans showing the restricted areas are available at the address given below where they may be examined during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended as aforesaid or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or that any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the 10th January 1978 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

HALTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Halton Borough Council (Halton Road (Part), Runcorn) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978
