

1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting by vehicles at any time on the north-west side of New Road, Bromyard, from a point 108 metres (355 ft.) south-west of its junction with High Street for a distance of 24 metres (79 ft.) in a south-westerly direction.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:—

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading goods;
- (c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;
- (d) delivering and collecting furniture and effects; and, where necessary, in connection with:—
- (e) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, electricity and water.

The Order will come into operation on the 17th January 1978.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at the Shirehall, Worcester between 9.30 a.m.-12.30 p.m. and 2 p.m.-4 p.m., from Monday to Friday inclusive.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant Section of the Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Section or of Section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act, or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made (such date stated in this Notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.
