

3. To remove the parking places on the north-west side of Stour Street between points 163 feet and 200 feet south-west of the south-west kerbline of High Street so as to provide a Hackney Carriage Rank. Other vehicles will be prohibited from parking at all times under the Canterbury Prohibition of Waiting Order 1970 from which the Street Parking Places Order had previously exempted them.

4. To remove the parking places on the south-east side of Roper Road from a point 180 to 185 feet from the south-west kerbline of St. Dunstons Street and from a point 210 feet to a point 272 feet from the south-west kerbline of St. Dunstons Street where waiting will henceforth be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday by virtue of the Canterbury Prohibition of Waiting Order 1970 as amended from which the Street Parking Places Order had previously exempted them.

5. To permit the parking of vehicles in the existing parking place in Marlowe Avenue to be in two rows of two parking bays parallel to the kerb instead of in a single row.

**G. The Canterbury City Council (Prohibition of Cycling) Order 1978.**

An Order under Section 1 of the R.T.R.A. to prohibit the riding of bicycles and tricycles along the following footpaths:

1. The entire length of Footpath 62 Westbere which runs from the southern footway of Island Road, Sturry between numbers 66 and 72 Island Road across the railway to a point on the south-east footway of Fordwich Road between numbers 21 and 23 Fordwich Road, Sturry.

2. The footpath from the eastern end of Pettman Close, Herne Bay to Canterbury Road, Herne Bay between 188 and 190 Canterbury Road, Herne Bay.

3. The entire length of Footpath 18 (Seasalter) which runs from Church Lane, Seasalter to Shamrock Avenue, Whitstable.

4. The footpath which runs from the southern footway of Grimthorpe Avenue, Whitstable between numbers 40 and 42 Grimthorpe Avenue, Whitstable to the northern footway of Martindown Road, Whitstable between numbers 28 and 30 Martindown Road.

**H. The Canterbury City Council (Former City of Canterbury) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 6) Order 1978.**

An Order under Sections 28, 31 and 84D(1) of the R.T.R.A. to amend the City of Canterbury (Parking Places) Order 1972:

1. So as to close the Black Griffin Lane Car Parks (Nos. 1, 2 and 3) and the St. Peter's Place Car Park in connection with the General Improvement Area whereby residents are to be provided in due course with private car parks.

2. To delete all references to Northgate No. 2, Rhodas Town and Whitefriars Car Parks which have not been provided for some time.

3. For the enlargement of the following car parks:

Castle Street No. 2, Municipal, Northgate Car Park (formerly known as Northgate No. 1), St. Radigunds Bridge and St. Radigunds Place car park. These are being provided to replace the Marlowe Car Park on a temporary basis.

4. The following new car parks to be provided for a maximum period of 12 hours parking by private motor vehicles and light commercial vehicles not exceeding 25 cwt. unladen weight:

(a) Notley Street (No. 2) Car Park on the south-west side of Notley Street at its junction with the south-east side of Clyde Street being the sites of numbers 16-28 Notley Street.

(b) Ivy Lane Car Park on the south-west side of Ivy Lane being the site of the former number 34 Ivy Lane.

5. To amend the charges payable in respect of the following car parks as set out below. N.B. Unless otherwise stated car parks listed are available for private motor vehicles and light commercial vehicles not exceeding 25 cwt. unladen weight and the charges will apply to those classes of vehicles.

The charges in other car parks will be unchanged.

6. Half-yearly season tickets for private motor vehicles and light commercial vehicles not exceeding 25 cwt. unladen weight will be available for all the Council's pay car parks except the Marlowe, Municipal, Orange Street and Watling Street Car Parks, Canterbury and the Gladstone Road Car Park, Whitstable at £25 plus V.A.T.

**J. The Canterbury City Council (Whitstable) (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1978.**

An Order under Sections 28, 31 and 84D(1) of the R.T.R.A. to amend the Whitstable (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1972 (as amended) to increase the charges applicable for the parking of private motor vehicles and other vehicles under one ton unladen weight in the Gladstone Road Car Park as follows:

Up to 1 hour	— 5p
1-2 hours	—15p
2-4 hours	—25p
Over 4 hours	—50p
