GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The Greater Manchester County Council (Lawson Street Passage, Manchester) (Prohibition of Driving) (City) Order 1976.

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd January 1978, the Manchester City Council as agents for the Greater Manchester County Council made an Order under section 1

of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of vehicles in the passageway adjacent to 53 Lawson Street, Blackley, from a point 19 metres south of the southerly kerb line of Lawson Street for a distance of 3 metres in a southerly direction.

MENDIP DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Mendip District Council (Off-Street Parking Places in Shepton Mallet) Order 1977
