ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967

The Hampshire (Gardeners Lane and Old Salisbury Lane, Romsey) (Width Restriction) Order 1978

HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Walnut Close, Broadway) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Hereford and Worcester propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972, Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to extend the existing prohibition of waiting by vehicles at any time on both sides of Walnut Close, Broadway, by a further 20 metres (66 feet) in a northerly direction.

Exceptions in the proposed Order will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading goods;
- (c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;
- (d) delivering and collecting furniture and effects;
- (e) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the supply of gas, electricity and water;
- (f) vehicles to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

An exemption in the Order also permits the waiting of disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's Orange Badge Scheme.
