NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Redbridge (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that in exercise of powers delegated by the Greater London Council the Council of the London Borough of Redbridge intends to make an Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, to amend further the Redbridge (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972, which imposes restrictions on vehicles, with certain exceptions, with regard to waiting, the offer or exposure for sale of goods from vehicles and on advertising activities in certain streets in the London Borough of Redbridge.

The effect of the proposed Order would be to extend these restrictions such that both waiting and loading in the area between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 194-196 Cranbrook Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 225-227 Cranbrook Road are prohibited at any time throughout the week.

Copies of the Redbridge (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972, the proposed Order and a copy of the Council's Statement of Reasons may be inspected during normal office hours at the Information Centre, Town Hall, High Road, Ilford, Essex, until 6th March 1978.

RUSHMOOR BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Rushmoor (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1978.

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th February 1978, the Rushmoor Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the County Council of Hampshire, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974, the effect of which will be that the Traffic Regulation Orders listed in the Schedule hereto shall have effect as if they included an exemption in accordance with 'The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975 which permit a disabled person's vehicle to wait for a maximum period of 2 hours except where a longer period of exemption exists. This exemption does not apply to any road during such times as the loading and unloading of goods is prohibited.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on the 13th February 1978, may be examined at the Town Hall, Farnborough and the Town Hall, Aldershot during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any of the requirements of the Act, or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 13th February 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
