WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967**

The County of Wiltshire (Various Streets, Devizes)

(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire County Council after considering representations and objections submitted in respect of the Order they propose to make under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended (a notice of which was published on 27th October 1977), have decided to amend the proposed Order in the following respects :

- (1) New Park Street—that the prohibition of waiting on the north side of New Park Street on the west side of the junction with Wharf Street shall apply to a length of 17 metres from that junction (instead of 27.5 metres).
- (2) New Park Road—that the proposed restrictions on waiting on the north-west side of New Park Road along the frontage of the Hospital shall not be implemented.
- (3) Hare and Hounds Street—that in addition waiting shall be prohibited at all times on the access road to Sutton Place leading from the south side of Hare and Hounds Street for a distance of 31 metres.
