RATING OF EMPTY PROPERTY

Notice is hereby given that the Gateshead Metropolitan Borough Council having implemented the provisions of Schedule 1 of the General Rate Act 1967, as amended by section 15 of the Local Government Act 1974, passed the following Resolution at its Meeting on the 3rd February 1977:

"That with effect from 1st April 1978, the following further amendment be made to the decision set out at Minute No. 1342(34)—1974/75, as amended by Minute No. 1223(27)—1975/77, relating to the rating of empty property:

The specific portion referred to in the first Schedule to the General Rate Act 1967 at paragraph 1 (2a) be 100 per cent. of the amount which would be payable if the property were occupied in relation to all classes of hereditaments liable to the charge in all parts of the rating area."

## GREATER LONDON COUNCIL NOTICES

### GREATER LONDON COUNCIL

LONDON BOROUGH OF SUTTON

*The Sutton (Prescribed Routes) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1978*

*The Sutton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 5) Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council on 6th February 1978, made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The effect of the Sutton (Prescribed Routes) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1978 will be to:

- (a) revoke the one-way working for vehicular traffic in West Street Lane imposed by the Sutton (Prescribed Route) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1967;
- (b) to prohibit vehicles from entering that length of carriageway:

(i) of Carshalton Park Road which lies between the north-western kerb-line of Ruskin Road and a point 3 metres north-west of that kerb-line;

(ii) of West Street Lane which lies between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 7 to 12 and 13 to 18 Beechwood Court, West Street Lane and a point 2 metres south-west of that party wall;

(A barrier will be erected in each length of carriageway (the location of which is indicated on plans contained in the Order));

- (c) to prohibit the right turn by vehicular traffic from Carshalton Road into Park Hill;
- (d) to compel the left turn by vehicular traffic from Beynon Road into Carshalton Park Road.

3. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 2 (b) above will not apply to:

- (i) pedal cycles (not being motor vehicles) which follow the route through the barrier indicated by traffic signs; or
- (ii) vehicles being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in certain circumstances.

4. The prohibitions and requirement referred to in paragraph 2 (b), (c) and (d) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

5. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 2 (c) above will not apply to a stage carriage, a scheduled express carriage, a school bus or a works bus.

6. The general effect of the Sutton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 5) Order 1978, will be further to amend the Sutton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976, so that in the lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this notice:

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;

(b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;

(c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, will be prohibited.

7. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 6 (a) and (b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" will apply.

8. A copy of each of the Orders, which will come into operation on 15th February 1978, of the Sutton (Prescribed Route) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1967, and of the Sutton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976 (and of the Orders which have previously amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made in Room B.21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

9. Copies of the Orders may be purchased from the Information Centre, Greater London Council, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

10. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the grounds that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to either of the Orders may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
