By a letter dated the 23rd January 1978, the Secretary of State for the Environment has in accordance with section 10 (2) of the Clean Air Act 1968, consented to the further postponement of the coming into operation of the Order.

The Order shall now become operative on the 1st October 1979.

##### CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

##### *The Borough of Slough No. 14 Smoke Control (Variation) Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Slough in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act, on the 30th December 1977, made an Order entitled *The Borough of Slough No. 14 Smoke Control (Variation) Order, 1977*, which amends the Borough of Slough No. 14 Smoke Control Order, 1971, by declaring that the buildings described in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be exempt from the operation of the said section 11, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include Anthracite, Coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st November 1978, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Slough at all reasonable times from Monday to Friday during the period of 6 weeks from the 10th February 1978.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

##### *The Borough of Slough No. 18 Smoke Control Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Slough in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act, on the 30th December 1977, made an Order entitled *The Borough of Slough No. 18 Smoke Control Order, 1977*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include Anthracite, Coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st November 1978, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Slough, at all reasonable times from Monday to Friday during the period of 6 weeks from the 10th February 1978.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

#### SCHEDULE

An area of approximately 520 acres situated in the western part of the Borough bounded on the north by Bath Road; on the west by Brook Path, part of Lower Cippenham Lane, and a line running in a southerly direction from the junction of Elmshott Lane and Lower Cippenham Lane to a point on the Borough boundary just east of Manor Farm; on the south by the Borough boundary; on the east by Twiches Lane, part of Cippenham Lane, Wood Lane, and a line running in a southerly direction from Wood Lane to a point on the Borough boundary opposite Moores Lane, Eton Wick.
