Now Rotherham Borough Council by a Resolution dated the 11th January 1978, under the provisions of Schedule I, paragraph 6 of the Clean Air Act 1956, have further postponed the coming into operation of the Order.

By a letter dated the 23rd January 1978, the Secretary of State for the Environment has in accordance with section 10 (2) of the Clean Air Act 1968, consented to the further postponement of the coming into operation of the Order.

The Order shall now become operative on the 1st October 1979.
