DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dorset (C25 Iwerne Minster to Tarrant Hinton Road) (One-Way) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 6th February 1978 the Dorset County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

When this Order comes into effect on 10th February 1978 the driving of vehicles on that part of the C25 Iwerne Minster to Tarrant Hinton Road (new carriageway) from a point approximately 20 yards north of its western junction with the A354 to its eastern junction with that road (A354) in other than an easterly direction will be prohibited.

DUDLEY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH

The Borough of Dudley (Saltwells Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1978
