#### Notice of Proposals

Notice is hereby given that the Council intend to revoke the parking Order made on the 15th December 1976, in respect of the management of the car parks at Angel Street, Brackla Street No. 1, Brackla Street No. 2, Tondu Road, Tremains Road and Brewery Lane, Bridgend, and intend to make a new Order to cover these car parks and to include the car parks at the Multi-Storey, Recreation Centre, Bridgend and Hillsboro Place, Porthcawl.

The proposed Order would make provisions as to the use of the parking places, and in particular, as to the vehicles or class of vehicles which may be entitled to use them; as to the conditions on which it may be used; as to the charges to be paid in connection with their use and to the removal therefrom of vehicles left there in contravention of the Order and the safe custody of the vehicles.

The proposed Order will operate every day of the week throughout the year and will make provision for a charge for parking of 10 pence per day, with season tickets at £4 per quarter plus VAT, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays, with no charge for the remaining part of the day or night. There will be no charge for parking at the Hillsboro Place car park, Porthcawl, during the period between 1st October to 31st March of each year. All classes of vehicles will be allowed to park at the Brewery Lane car park, Bridgend, while the remaining parks are restricted to vehicles of unladen weight of 30 cwt. or less.

A copy of the draft Order, map and statement of the Authority's resolution for proposing to make the Order, can be inspected during normal office hours at the Chief Executive Officer's Department, Ogwr Borough Council, Floor 3, Room 309, Municipal Buildings, Queen Street, Bridgend.
