SCHEDULE 1

No Waiting at any time

Blandford Alley

west side, from its junction with Brewery Street to a point 28 metres north of that junction;
east side, from its junction with Brewery Street to a point 14 metres north of that junction.

Brewery Street, both sides, for its whole distance.

Brewery Street, (*Northleg, cul de sac*) both sides, for its whole distance.

Cherry Orchard Lane

west side, from its junction with High Street to a point 27 metres north of its junction with Sheep Street;
east side, from its junction with High Street to a point 45 metres north of its junction with Sheep Street.

Cricklade Road

north side, from its junction with Swindon Street to a point 78 metres west of that junction;
south side, from its junction with Swindon Street to its junction with The Elms.

Eastrop

north side, from its junction with Cherry Orchard Lane to a point 14 metres east of that junction;

both sides, from its junction with Lechlade Road to a point 46 metres east of that junction;
north side, from a point 14 metres west of its junction with Market Place to its junction with Cherry Orchard Lane;
south side, from its junction with Cherry Orchard Lane to a point 30 metres west of that junction.

Kings Avenue, both sides, from its junction with Brewery Street to a point 14 metres south of that junction.

Lechlade Road

west side, from its junction with Cricklade Road to a point 59 metres north of its junction with St. Michael's Avenue;
east side, from its junction with High Street to a point 75 metres north of that junction.

Market Place Road (joining *Sheep Street* to *High Street*) both sides, for its whole distance.

Sheep Street

south side, for its whole distance;
north side, from its junction with Vicarage Lane to a point 14 metres east of that junction;
from its junction with Cherry Orchard Lane to a point 14 metres west of that junction.

St. Michael's Avenue, both sides, from its junction with Lechlade Road to a point 14 metres west of that junction.

Shrivenham Road

east side, from its junction with Brewery Street to a point 60 metres south of that junction;
west side, from its junction with Swindon Road to a point 21 metres south of that junction.

Swindon Road, east side, from its junction with Shrivenham Road to a point 28 metres south of that junction.

Swindon Street

west side, from its junction with Cricklade Road to a point 66 metres south of that junction;
from its northern junction with The Green to a point 9.5 metres north of that junction;
from its southern junction with The Green to its northern junction with The Green.
east side, from its junction with High Street to a point 60 metres south of that junction;
from its junction with Brewery Street to a point 35 metres north of that junction.

The South Yorkshire County Council (Shirecliffe Lane, Sheffield) (Experimental) (One-way Traffic) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the South Yorkshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 9 of the Road to its junction with Shirley Road other than in a of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Shirecliffe Lane at Sheffield which extends from its junction with Pitsmoor Road to its junction with Shirley Road other than in a north-westerly direction.

The South Yorkshire County Council (Christchurch Road Sheffield) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1978
