

maintenance, alteration, repair or removal of any main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telegraph line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1978 under, in, on, over, along or across the highway or any land adjacent to the highway, and;

- (c) in accordance with a special authorisation for that use given by or on behalf of the Gwent County Council, the Islwyn Borough Council or the Chief Officer of Police for the Gwent Constabulary.
