Length and sides of road in the District of Epping Forest
Roding Lane, a length from its junction with Chigwell High Road, north-west for a distance of 18.3 metres.

EPPING FOREST DISTRICT COUNCIL

Epping Forest District (The Broadway and High Road, Loughton) (Designated Parking Places for Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that the Epping Forest District Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Essex, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council, has made an Order under sections 28 (1) and 31 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the use of the two designated parking places (one each in The Broadway and High Road, Loughton) described in column 1 of the Schedule hereto by any vehicles other than disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant badge. The position in which such vehicles may park is shown in column 2 of the Schedule.

The Order will come into operation on 20th February 1978.

A copy of the Order, together with a map showing the locations of the two proposed designated parking places, may be examined at the Council Offices, 323 High Street, Epping; Old Station Road, Loughton; and Town Hall, Waltham Abbey, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from 17th February 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

The Mid Glamorgan County Council (Classified Un-Numbered Miskin to Pendoylan Road) (Weight Restriction on Vehicles of Over 3 tons) Order 1978.
