

The Order will come into operation on Monday, 20th February 1978, and a copy of the Order, together with a map showing the restricted areas is available at the Borough Secretary's Department (East Annexe), Town Hall, Warrington, during the usual office hours, Monday to Friday.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967 AS AMENDED

The Warwickshire County Council Prohibition of Waiting, Clemens Street and Brunswick Street, Leamington Spa

The Borough of Royal Leamington Spa (Central Area) Traffic Regulation and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting (Variation No. 4) Order 1978.

Notice is hereby given that the Warwickshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times (except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden) in Clemens Street and Brunswick Street, Leamington Spa as mentioned in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

Copies of the proposed Order and an Order already made under the said Act which is affected by the proposals, together with maps showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the County Secretary's Department, Shire Hall, Warwick and at the Secretary and Solicitor's Department, Town Hall, Leamington Spa on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, during normal office hours.

WATFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Watford (High Street and Hempstead Road) (Prohibition of Driving) (Amendment) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the Watford Borough Council, with the consent of the Hertfordshire County Council, propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to amend the Prohibition of Driving Orders in the Schedule to permit the following additional exemptions to those Orders:

WELWYN HATFIELD DISTRICT COUNCIL

Traffic Regulation Order

Notice is hereby given that the Welwyn Hatfield District Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Hertfordshire propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of the Order will be to vary the London Traffic (Prohibition of Waiting) (Welwyn Garden City) Regulations 1965 and the Welwyn Garden City (Town Centre) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1967 so as to prohibit the waiting of vehicles except disabled persons vehicles on the south-east side of Parkway, Welwyn Garden City from a point 13.76 metres (15 yards) from its junction with Bridge Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.
