NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971, SECTION 210

The Borough of North Wolds (Melbourne) Public Path Diversion Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on the 2nd February 1978 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Council of the Borough of North Wolds as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order if confirmed without modifications will be to divert the public right of way running from a point at the eastern corner of field O.S. 9212 in the Parish of Melbourne in the County of Humberside and running in a generally south-south-westerly direction along the eastern boundary of field O.S. 9212 and O.S. 8400 to a point at the southern corner of field O.S. 8400 being part of footpath Number 4 in the Parish of Melbourne on the Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way to a line running from a point at the northern corner of field O.S. 9212 in the Parish of Melbourne in the County of Humberside and running in a generally south-south-westerly direction along the western boundary of field O.S. 9212 thence in a generally west-north-westerly direction along the northern boundary of field O.S. 8400 thence in a generally south-south-westerly direction along the western boundary of field O.S. 8400 thence in a generally easterly direction along the southern boundary of field O.S. 8400 to a point at the southern corner of field O.S. 8400 being part of footpath Number 4 in the Parish of Melbourne on the Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way being a width of not less than 4 feet throughout its length.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the North Wolds Borough Council Divisional Office, Burnby Hall, Pocklington, and may be inspected free of charge at the said Divisional Office between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays (Mondays to Thursdays) and 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Fridays.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Director of Administration, the Council of the Borough of North Wolds at the Town Hall, Bridlington, not later than the 17th March 1978 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council of the Borough of North Wolds may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted to the Secretary of State with the Order.

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

The Wycombe District Council (Footpath No. 37, Abbotswood, Speen) Public Path Diversion Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that on the 23rd November 1977, the Wycombe District Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed is to divert the section of footpath No. 37 in Speen in the County of Buckingham running in a northerly direction from a point close to the eastern most corner of the property known as Abbotswood for a distance of approximately 445 feet to the point where the said footpath meets bridleway No. 36 to a line running in a slightly north-easterly direction from the point of commencement of the section of footpath No. 37 being diverted for a distance of approximately 135 feet to a point also on the said bridleway No. 36 but approximately 440 feet south-east from the point of termination of the diverted section of the said footpath No. 37.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at the offices of Wycombe District Council, District Council Offices, Queen Victoria Road, High

This Order becomes operative as from the 17th February 1978, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may under section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, within 6 weeks from the 17th February 1978, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

The Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley (Undefined Footpath at Wombwell) Public Path Diversion Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 16th January 1978, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert a section of the public right of way (which links Dove Road and Overdale Road, Wombwell, Barnsley) between a point 15 yards south of its junction with Overdale Road and a point 35 yards north of its junction with Dove Road, onto a shorter and more commodious line.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it have been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Department of Administration and Law, Town Hall, Barnsley and at the Area Housing Office, Town Hall, Wombwell during normal office hours. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
