1. An Order under section 7 and 20 of the Highways Act 1959.
 - (a) providing that the new highway which he proposes to construct over the Grand Union Canal, shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order came into operation ; and
 - (b) authorising him to construct as part of that new highway a bridge over the navigable waters of the Grand Union Canal ; and
2. An Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him to stop up part of the existing A423 trunk road.

Any person aggrieved by the Orders and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or the Highways Act 1971 or on the ground that any requirement of either of those Acts, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 24th February 1978, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1976

Windermoor Internal Drainage District

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11(4) and 109(6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, has now made an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the North West Water Authority under section 11(1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976 making provision for the abolition of the Windermoor Internal Drainage District and the Internal Drainage Board thereof.

The Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless during the period ending with 28th March 1978 a memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial (as prescribed in Article 6 of the Land Drainage (River Authorities) General Regulations 1965 (S.I. 1965/443) as applied to Water Authorities by section 9 of the Water Act 1973) praying that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.
