## ASHFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Ashford Borough (Various Roads, Ashford) (Restriction of Waiting) (Variation) Order No. 1 of 1978*

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th February 1978 the Ashford Borough Council made the above-named Order pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Kent County Council and under the provisions of sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84d (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

2. From its junction with Park Street in a southerly direction to its junction with Park Street.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from the 20th February 1978 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
