

The effect of the Order is to divert part of the footpath which runs from Church Street southwards for 200 metres. The diverted path will run from the same point on Church Street in a generally southerly direction following the farm road for approximately 200 metres thence south-eastwards for 50 metres to rejoin the existing path.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at The Vale of White Horse District Council Offices, The Abbey House, Abingdon, and the area office, Market Place, Faringdon, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Monday to Friday.

The Order becomes operative as from 14th February 1978 but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act within six weeks from 23rd February 1978, make application for the purpose to the High Court.—Dated 23rd February 1978.

The Guildford Borough Council (Footpath No. 481 and 558 Ash) Public Path Diversion Order 1978

The District Council of Rochford Public Path No. 2 (Stambridge) Diversion Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order, made on 1st February 1978 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or

to be confirmed, as an unopposed Order by the Rochford District Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert the public right of way running from the extreme northern end of Little Stambridge Hall Lane and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for a distance of approximately 818 yards to the stile in the western boundary of O.S. Field 6286 to a line commencing at the footbridge 147 yards from the southern end of Footpath 20, Stambridge and proceeding on the southern side of the watercourse for a distance of 450 yards to the point where the watercourse turns north, then proceeding in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 yards then in an easterly direction for 227 yards to the western boundary of O.S. Field 6286, then in a southerly direction along the western side of the western boundary of O.S. Field 6286 for a distance of 113 yards to the stile.
