Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Wages Council (England and Wales)

The Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing Wages Council (England and Wales) hereby gives notice of proposals for (1) varying the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages (Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing) (England and Wales) Order 1977 (Order WD(109)); (2) amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration as set out in the Wages (Dressmaking and Women's Light Clothing) (England and Wales) (Holidays) Order 1976 (Order WD(107)); and (3) the revocation of Orders WD(109) and WD(107). The Wages Council intends that the revised provisions shall come into operation on 25th March 1978 except those provisions relating to holiday remuneration which are intended to come into effect on 6th April 1978.

Particulars of the proposals are contained in the Wages Council's Notices WD(110) and WD(111) copies of which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below. The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the proposals of made within 14 days from 28th February 1978. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections and quote the number of the Wages Council's Notice of Proposals WD(110) and WD(111).
