The application is supplementary to an existing Licence No. 6/33/37/221 authorising abstraction by the Applicant from underground strata at grid reference TL 892 619 in the said parish at the rate of 12,000 gallons per hour, 184,000 gallons per day and 10,000,000 gallons per year. The existing licence would continue in force. The total quantities to be abstracted after the grant of a supplementary licence would therefore be 24,000 gallons per hour, 434,000 gallons per day and 30,000,000 gallons per year.

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL FOR THE VARIATION OF A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that the South West Water Authority has formulated proposals for the variation of a Licence to abstract water as follows:

Licence No. 14/50/07/0158/01/00 authorises the abstraction from the River Yeo at National Grid Reference SS 393221 in the Parish of Parkham in the area of the Torridge District Council of 2,273.05 cubic metres (500,000 gallons) of water per day, with a total of 340,960 cubic metres (75 million gallons) per annum, subject to a condition that no abstraction shall be effected when the river flow at the point of abstraction is less than 2,273.05 cubic metres (500,000 gallons) per day.

The proposed variation is to extend the operation of the Licence to 31st March 1980, instead of when the trunk mains from the Meldon Reservoir are completed.

A copy of the draft variation, and of any relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Authority at 3-5 Barnfield Road, Exeter, and at Grenville House, Boutport Street, Barnstaple at all reasonable hours during the period beginning on 1st March 1978 and ending on the 30th March 1978.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

YORK CITY COUNCIL

The City of York (No. 7) Smoke Control Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City, of York in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 7th February

1978, made an Order entitled "The City of York (No. 7) Smoke Control Order 1978", declaring an area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st November 1979, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Chief Executive and Town Clerk's Office, Guildhall, York, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 7th March 1978.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, the Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.
