*The Trunk Road (Various Lay-Bys and Lengths of Road)  
(Mitchel Troy, Newbridge-on-Usk and Dixon, Gwent)  
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 197*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974. The effect of the Order will be:

- (i) to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle at any time in the lengths of lay-by, lengths of superseded trunk road or access road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice; and
- (ii) to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle between the hours of 8 am and 6 pm on any day in the lengths of lay-by, or lengths of superseded trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice (a) for a longer period than 4 hours or (b) if a period of less than 4 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting of the same vehicle in the same length of lay-by or length of superseded trunk road.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of lay-by or lengths of superseded trunk road specified in the Schedules to this Notice for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the trunk road, lay-by, superseded trunk road or access road or the services therein; or to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

Exceptions are also provided in the Order to enable a disabled person's vehicle which displays a disabled person's badge to wait in any of the lengths of lay-by or lengths of superseded trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.
