*Disabled Persons' Parking Place in Ascot Road*

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council on 13th March 1978 made the Merton (Free Parking Place) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 1978 under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Order will be—

- (a) to designate a parking place on the south-east side of Ascot Road, 6 metres in length, fronting No. 32 Ascot Road in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period during the permitted hours without charge;  
 (b) to provide that the parking place will be in operation between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);  
 (c) to specify, in respect of the parking place, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled persons' badge (commonly referred to as "the Orange Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975 may be left therein; and

- (d) to provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking place in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation for the purposes of the placing of traffic signs, etc., on 23rd March 1978 and for all other purposes on 27th March 1978 and of the Merton (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 1977 can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Room B.21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

4. Copies of the Order may be purchased from the Information Centre, Greater London Council, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement thereof or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
