(d) to provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking place in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc.

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation for the purposes of the placing of traffic signs, etc., on 23rd March 1978 and for all other purposes on 27th March 1978 and of the Merton (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 1) Order 1977 can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Room B.21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.
