## WAGES COUNCIL

### EMPLOYMENT PROTECTION ACT 1975

#### *Hairdressing Undertakings Wages Council (Great Britain)*

### EMPLOYMENT PROTECTION ACT 1975

#### *Aerated Waters Wages Council (England and Wales)*

## DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
