

## BERKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Royal County of Berkshire (Palmer School Road Extension, Wokingham) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978.*

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at any time on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The usual exemptions for disabled drivers, loading and unloading etc., have been included in the draft Order, copies of which together with the explanatory statement and map can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Wokingham District Council and at the County Surveyor's Office, Traffic Management Section, First Floor, Kennet House, Kings Road, Reading.

Objections to the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made should be sent in writing to the undersigned, quoting reference ENV 222 011 HE by not later than 4th May 1978.

## SCHEDULE

*Palmer School Road Extension (Outside Old People's Home)*

1. Both sides—from its junction with Palmer School Road Extension southeastwards to Palmer Court car park, a distance of approximately 12 metres.

2. Northwest side—from its junction with Palmer School Road northeastwards for a distance of approximately 20 metres.

3. Northwest side—from its northeastern end southwestwards for a distance of approximately 8 metres.

4. Northeast side—from its junction with Palmer Court car park northeastwards to its northeastern end.

5. Northeastern end, a distance of approximately 6 metres. (537)

*Royal County of Berkshire (Woodlands Park Road, Waltham Road and Cannon Lane, Maidenhead) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to:

1. Prohibit waiting at any time on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
2. Prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

The Order will include the usual exemptions for disabled drivers, loading and unloading etc.

Copies of the draft Order, explanatory statement and map can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead and at the County Surveyor's Office, Traffic Management Section, First Floor, Kennet House, Kings Road, Reading.

*Prohibition of waiting at any time*

1. *Woodlands Park Road*, north side, from its junction with Cannon Lane eastwards for a distance of approximately 30 metres.

2. *Waltham Road*, north-west side, from its junction with Cannon Lane south-westwards for a distance of approximately 25 metres.

3. *Cannon Lane*, both sides, from its junction with Waltham Road/Woodlands Park Road, northwards for a distance of approximately 15 metres.

## SCHEDULE 2

*Prohibition of waiting, 8 a.m.-6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday*  
*Waltham Road*, from a point approximately 13 metres north of its junction with Willant Close, northwards and eastwards for a distance of approximately 134 metres. (541)

*Royal County of Berkshire (Footpath between Harmar Close and A329 London Road, Wokingham) (Prohibition of Driving and Cycling) Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle or bicycle or tricycle from driving or riding along the footpath which extends between Harmar Close and A329 London Road, Wokingham.

Copies of the draft Order, explanatory statement and map can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Wokingham District Council and at the County Surveyor's Office, Traffic Management Section, First Floor, Kennet House, Kings Road, Reading.

## BERKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Royal County of Berkshire (St. Cloud Way, Bad-Godesberg Way and Frascati Way, Maidenhead) (24 hour main carriageway clearway) Order, 1978.*

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council have made an Order under sections 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which is to:

1. Revoke the Borough of Maidenhead (Urban Clearway) Order 1971 insofar as it relates to the roads specified in the Schedule to this notice.
2. Make the roads specified in the Schedule to this notice 24 hours main carriageway clearways.

This will mean that no driver will be able to wait on the main carriageways of any of the roads listed in the Schedule to this notice, at any time.

Vehicles will be allowed to stop where the driver has been instructed to do so by a police constable or by a traffic warden, or where the driver of a vehicle is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control, or where the vehicle is being used in connection with—

- (a) any building operation or demolition;
- (b) the removal of obstruction to traffic;
- (c) in certain circumstances in exercise of statutory powers;
- (d) police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes.

The Order will come into operation on 10th April 1978.

Copies of the Order and relevant map can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead and at the County Surveyor's Office, Traffic Management Section, First Floor, Kennet House, Kings Road, Reading.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended as aforesaid or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 3rd April 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
