The County of Cornwall (Truro) (Experimental Restriction on Waiting) Order 1978

Notice is hereby given that on the 30th March 1978, the Cornwall County Council made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to regulate traffic at Truro for an initial period of six months from the 7th April 1978, by prohibiting (subject to the normal exceptions operating in Cornwall) the waiting of vehicles between 8 a.m.-6 p.m. daily in that length of the Trafalgar Roundabout-Malpas Road (Class III) at Sunny Corner, Truro, which extends from a point 920 yards south-east of its junction with Pendeen Road/Trevelva Road for a distance of 90 yards in an easterly direction.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The Devon County Council (Watersmeet Road, Lynmouth) (Clearway) Order, 1978

Notice is hereby given that on 31st March 1978 the Devon County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from stopping, 1st May to 30th September, in every year, on that length of Watersmeet Road, Lynmouth (A.39) which extends from a point 347 metres (434 yards) south-east of its junction with Lynmouth Hill at Lynmouth, to a point 138 metres (151 yards) north of its junction with B.3223 at Hillsford Bridge.

There are exceptions in the Order to allow vehicles to stop: (a) for the removal of any obstruction to traffic; (b) in certain circumstances in exercise of statutory powers or duties; (c) in certain emergencies; and (d) for police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes.
