Notice is hereby given that the North Devon District Council proposes to make Orders under section 31 (1) and section 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and the Local Government Act 1972 and all other enabling powers, to control the use of the parking places named in the schedules to this notice, which show the classes of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum periods for waiting and the scale of charges proposed for each parking place.
