### NORTH EAST DERBYSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

*North East Derbyshire District No. 26 (Clay Cross-West)  
Smoke Control Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the North East Derbyshire District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, on 31st March 1978 made an Order entitled "The North East Derbyshire District No. 26 (Clay Cross-West) Smoke Control Order 1978" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State, Department of the Environment, for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before 1st September 1980, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State, Department of the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at County Library, Kenning Park, Holmgate Road, Clay Cross, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays, during the period of 7 weeks from 7th April 1978.
