#### WARWICK DISTRICT COUNCIL

##### CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

*Warwick District Council (No. 11) Smoke Control Order, 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the Warwick District Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 5th April 1978, made an Order entitled "Warwick District Council (No. 11) Smoke Control Order 1978" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include: anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Fireplaces in buildings or parts of buildings separately occupied without gas supply shall be exempted from the operation of section 11 of the said Act on condition that only authorised fuels as declared by regulations made under the said Act and kindling sticks and paper shall be used in the fireplaces.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st January 1979, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Secretary and Solicitor's Office, Town Hall, Leamington Spa, at all reasonable times during the period 6 weeks from the 14th April 1978.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Department of the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, object to the confirmation of the Order.

##### THE SCHEDULE

## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

#### BASILDON DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The District of Basildon (Luncies Road/Sandon Road, Basildon) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that Basildon District Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Essex County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Essex Police have made the above Order.

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 10th April 1978 is to prohibit waiting at all times on both sides of Luncies Road from the eastern kerbline of its junction with Rippleside eastwards for a distance of 56 metres and on both sides of Sandon Road from its junction with Luncies Road southwards for a distance of 40 metres.

A copy of the Order, a plan showing the area affected by the Order and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Council Offices, Fodderwick, Basildon, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., on Mondays to Fridays.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from the 7th April 1978, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
