### NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1959

*The West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council (Part of Path from Well Lane to Crosshills Drive, Kippax) Public Path Extinguishment Order 1978.*

The above-named Order, made on 30th March 1978 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order, by West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to extinguish the public right of way running from a point at the western end of Well Lane, Kippax, adjoining No. 35 Well Lane at Map Reference 4138 3030 in a generally south-westerly direction for approximately 53 yards to its junction with the new footpath at Map Reference 4135 3026.

A copy of the Order, and of the map contained in it, has been deposited at the Information Desk, County Hall, Wakefield, and at Leeds City Council Offices, Main Street, Garforth, and may be there inspected free of charge during office hours, Mondays to Fridays.

#### *The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (No. ) Traffic Order 197*

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The effect of the Order would be to prohibit vehicular traffic from entering:

- High Street, Walthamstow, between Colebrook Road and Buxton Road;
- Palmerston Road, between High Street, Walthamstow and a point 5'00 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Osborne Grove;
- Willow Walk, between High Street, Walthamstow and a point 5'00 metres north-west of the north-western kerbline of Selborne Road

between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Saturdays.

3. Exemption would be provided in the Order in respect of:

- any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in any emergency or any vehicle being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided they comply with the one-way working in High Street, Walthamstow; and
- anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

4. The above-mentioned prohibitions currently have effect by virtue of Experimental Traffic Orders.

5. A copy of the proposed Order and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until 28th April 1978 in Room B.21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.
