### WEST YORKSHIRE METROPOLITAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*The West Yorkshire County Council (Calderdale)  
(Traffic Regulation) (No. 10) Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council have made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit vehicles entering or leaving Bob Lane, Halifax at its junction with Sandhall Green. ### METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF SOLIHULL

*The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Park Avenue,  
Solihull) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1978*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull on 6th April 1978 made the above Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day in the months of July and August on the following lengths of road:
